

Special case No. 78 of 2025

Accused Aznish Kumar is produced from JC.

CS has already been submitted and copy was served.

Bail petition as filed for the said accused on 01.11.2025 is taken up for hearing.

It appears from the report of the IO that the victim was properly informed about the bail petition but none turned up for the victim.

According to the submission of the Ld. Counsel for the accused, the said accused is in custody for more than 70 days and the victim refused her medico legal examination. On this ground prayer was made to release the accused on bail.

Ld. Special PP raised objection and submitted that the victim was rescued from Bihar and according to the submission of Ld. Special PP, if the accused be released on bail at this stage, the trial will be hampered.

Heard both sides.

Considering all aspects, I am not inclined to release the accused on bail prior to the examination of the victim.

The bail prayer stands rejected.
