The accused **Aznish Kumar @ Ritesh** is produced from JC.

Ld. Special PP is present.

Ld. Advocate for the accused is also present.

None turned up for the victim in spite of service of notice upon the victim/her family members.

Bail petition filed for the said accused.

Heard Ld. Advocate for the accused and Ld. Special PP.

Perused the CD and the statement of the victim recorded U/s 183 BNSS.

It appears that the victim and her guardian repeatedly refused for medical examination of the victim.

I have considered the statement of the victim recorded U/s 183 BNSS.

Considering all, I think that the accused may be released on interim bail up to 17.01.2026 in spite of strong objection from Ld. Special PP.

Accused namely **Aznish Kumar @ Ritesh** may be released on his furnishing bond of Rs. 4,000/- with two registered sureties of Rs. 2,000/- each subject to the satisfaction of Ld. ACJM, Sealdah on condition that he will turn up on the date as will be fixed by this court, id, to JC.

If on bail to **17.01.2026** for appearance and consideration of charge.
