State Vs Putul Molla @ Reyaz

Order No 4
16.02.2026

Accused Putul Molla @ Reyaz is produced in court from JC.
He is remanded to JC till 26.02.2026.
Today is fixed for hearing the bail application.
Ld Lawyer for the accused and Ld PP in charge are present.

Ld Advocate for the accused petitioner has submitted that no bail application is filed / pending and / or disposed of or rejected by any Higher forum.
He has submitted that the accused is in JC since 02.02.2026. That there was a love affair between the VG and present petitioner. That the VG herself left her parental house and went to her aunt's house. That this petitioner simply helped her in such journey. That he is falsely implicated and victimized. He has pointed out that the father of the VG has not appeared in court despite service of notice upon him for participation in the bail hearing. That it indicates that he has no objection.

Ld PP in charge has produced the Case Diary.
He has referred to the statement given by the VG herself before the IO and Ld Magistrate. That there is a marked difference in the version of the victim girl made before the IO and Ld Magistrate. So, Ld PP in charge has left the matter of bail to the discretion of the court.

Perused the case record as well as the CD including the contents of the written complaint, statements of the witnesses recorded by the IO and Ld Magistrate, medico-legal examination reports of the VG and the accused/petitioner, seizure lists and other materials.
It has been the consistent stand of the VG that she left her home with the petitioner at her own will. The allegation of physical relation is not substantiated by the VG before Ld Magistrate. The father of the VG did not appear in court despite service of notice upon him, as reflected from the document found in the CD. Further custodial detention of the petitioner is not necessary.
Considering the statement of the VG herself before Ld Magistrate, the bail application is allowed.

Accused may find a bail of Rs 3000/- with one surety for like amount on condition to meet the IO once a week for next two months or till submission of report in final form, whichever is earlier.
Return the CD.
If on bail, to date ie 06.03.2026 for IO's report.
