Today, the date is fixed for appearance and supply of copy.

On perusal of the earlier order sheet, it appears that the earlier order being Order No. 07 was passed on 16.04.2024, but in the order-sheet, due to inadvertence, the date has been wrongly noted as 14.04.2026 instead of 16.04.2026.

The sole accused person on court bail, namely, Ashoke Karar @ Asoke Kanrar @ Ashok Karar is present by filing hazira and also files a petition praying for confirmation of the interim bail on the ground stated therein along with some xerox copy of medical document. Let the same be kept with the case record.

Ld. Advocate for the accused petitioner is present.

Ld. Special PP is present.

One petition is filed on behalf of the de facto complainant praying for time on the ground stated therein.

Ld. Advocate Sri Saswati Mitra from the LADCS Panel is present and submits that she has no contact with the de facto complainant and he has not filed any petition today on behalf of the de facto complainant.

On repeated calls, none appears for the de facto complainant to move the petition.

Now, the petition praying for confirmation of the interim bail is taken up for hearing.

Ld. Advocate for the accused person submits that the accused person is suffering from lymbar spondylosis and presently, he is residing at a remote village at Sonatala under P.S – Udaynarayanpur, Howrah and as he is in urgent of need of better treatment, he is in need of staying in his residence place under Bantra P.S. Accordingly, he prays for confirmation of the interim bail and waiving the condition of not to enter into the jurisdiction of the Bantra P.S.

Considering the submission of the Ld. Advocate for the accused person, the Inspector-in-Charge of Bantra P.S is directed to submit a report with regard to the present conduct and allegation against the accused person and to ascertain whether the accused is abiding by the conditions imposed by this Court in the earlier order of not to enter the jurisdiction of Bantra P.S.

Let the interim bail of the accused person be extended till the next date.

Let a copy of this order and the order dated 16/04/2026 be sent to the Inspector-in-Charge of Bantra P.S for information and taking necessary action.

Ld. Special PP is directed to notify the de facto complainant ensuring her presence on the next date by mentioning the next date and purpose of the said date.

Fix 20/07/2026 for appearance of the above stated accused person and report from the Inspector-in-Charge of Bantra Police Station.
