Issue notice upon the Ops calling upon them to show cause by **17.01.19** as to why the claim of the Petitioner (s) shall not be allowed. To date of S/R of notice. Requisites for S/R by ordinary post as well as through registered Post at once.

The Petitioner (s) paid a Court Fees of Rs. **30/-** only which is deficit by an amount of **Rs. 2,970/-**. The petitioner (s) also file a petitioner under rule 331 (2) of the West Bengal Motor Vehicles Rules, 1989 as he/ she/ they is/ are unable to pay the deficit Court on account of their poor financial circumstances and prays for necessary relief.
