Today is fixed for appearance of the parties and hearing of the case.

Both parties are present. They are examined on oath. Self attested photocopies of their Aadhaar Cards and Marriage Certificate are marked as Exhibit 1 to Exhibit 3.

They have stated on oath that their marriage was registered on 18.02.2010 as per Special Marriage Act, 1954 and social marriage was held on 02.06.2010 as per Hindu Rites and Customs.

After marriage, they have resided together as husband and wife for almost 14 years. They are blessed with two male child namely Meghadri Bera and Anurag Bera. Then some disputes cropped up between the parties and their relationship has been deteriorated. As a result, both the petitioners are living separately since 20.02.2024.

Both of them reside within the jurisdiction of this Court.

There appears no chance of any reconciliation or their reunion. They have filed the application under Section 28 of the Special Marriage Act, 1954 voluntarily. The application does not appear to be the result of any collusive act of the parties.

I am satisfied that no fraud, coercion or collusion is there in between the petitioners in filing this application. I find no impediment in allowing the same.

Court fees paid are sufficient.

Hence, it is

O R D E R E D

that the application under section 28 of the Special Marriage Act, 1954 be and the same is allowed.

The parties do get a decree of divorce on mutual consent.

The marriage subsisting between Tapati Kalapahar (Bera) and Pralay Bera stands dissolved from the date of this order.
