Accused namely **Ajimuddin Sk** files a petition praying for pleading guilty.
Hd. Ld. Advocate for the accused and Ld. APP. Perused the case record and the petition filed by the sole accused.
Perused the petition and considering the submissions.
The accused intended to plead guilty before this court.
I find the petition filed by the accused is tenable and valid in law.
Hence the petition is considered and allowed.
The accused is examined u/s251 Cr. PC.
The contents of offence is read over and explained to the accused. The accused pleaded guilty by saying "AMI DOSH SIKAR KORECHI".
Hence the accused is convicted u/s 252 Cr. PC.
I heard the convict regarding the punishment of the offence. The convict pleaded mercy.
Considering the plea of the convict I take lenient view in respect of the punishment of the convict.
Hence, it is

ORDERED

that the accused person namely **Ajimuddin Sk** is found guilty for the offence punishable u/s 188 of IPC and 51 N DM Act and he is sentenced to pay fine of Rs .100/- for every offence (totaling Rs. 200/-) i/d the convict shall suffer SI for 15 days subject to the period already undergone byhim.
Let the seized articles be returned immediately to the accused person.
Later:
The accused files a photocopy of the receipt showing payment of fine of Rs.200/- vide slip No. 986 dt 27.08.2024.
