The application u/s 483 BNSS filed by accused / petitioner Dipak Das, son of Late Chitta Das in connection with GR case no. 02/2026 corresponding to Frezerganj Coastal P.S. Case No. 180/2025 dated 31.12.2025 u/s 326(g)/126(2)/115(2)/324(5)/326(6)/79/351(2) BNS is taken up for hearing.

Ld. Advocate for the accused person submits that no such application u/s 483 BNSS/439 Cr.PC is either rejected or pending before the Hon'ble High Court prior to this application. It is also submitted that the present accused petitioner is innocent and has been falsely implicated in this case. As such, he prayed for bail of the accused petitioner.

Ld. P.P-in-charge produces the case diary and raises objection to the prayer for bail u/s 483 of BNSS/439 Cr.PC of the present accused petitioner.

DC is present and raises no objection. In fact the defacto complainant namely Janaki Das who is the mother of accused has filed a petition supported by affidavit stating that she has got no objection if the bail prayer of the accused is allowed.

Heard both sides.

I have perused the case diary and other material on record as well as the TCR.

It appears that the accused petitioner is in custody since 01.01.2026.

So, considering the period of detention and the no objection petition filed by the defacto complainant against the bail prayer of the accused and the nature and gravity of the offence, this Court is of the opinion that there is no need to detain the accused person furthermore for the sake of investigation. Hence, prayer for bail u/s 483 BNSS/439 of Cr.PC of the accused petitioner is allowed.

Hence, it is,

**Ordered**

that the bail prayer is allowed. Accordingly, accused/petitioner namely Dipak Das, son of Late Chitta Das may find bail of Rs. 5,000/- with two registered sureties of Rs. 2,500/-, subject to the satisfaction of Ld. ACJM Kakdwip on further condition to appear before the Ld. Trial Court on each and every date so fixed.

This Criminal Misc Case u/s 483 BNSS thus stands disposed of.
