Today has been fixed for S/R, A/D and appearance of the opposite parties.

The petitioner has filed his hazira through his Ld Advocate.

No S/R upon the opposite parties has been received.

A petition has been filed on behalf of the petitioner praying for extension of the interim order passed on 01.08.2024 in this case. The said petition is supported by the affidavit of the tadbirkarak of the petitioner.

Ld Advocate appearing on behalf of the petitioner submitted that the operation of the impugned order was stayed by the Court of Revision on 01.08.2024 and the said stay order may be extended further.

This case has been filed challenging Order dated 20.06..2024 passed by the Executive Magistrate, Kakdwip in MF Case No.453 of 2024 arising out of a proceeding U/s. 144 of CrPC.

Under the law any order passed U/s. 144(2) Cr.P.C. remains in force for 60 days from the date of passing of the said order.

Thus, the impugned order which was passed on 20.06.2024 has lost its force after 20.08.2023. Therefore, there is no need to stay the operation of an order which has no legal force or entity.

Accordingly, the stay petition filed by the petitioner today is misconceived and accordingly, the same is rejected.

Petitioner is directed to take fresh steps for service of notice upon the opposite parties of this case.
