Today is fixed for hearing the petition for amendment of the petition u/s. 125 of CrPC filed by the petitioner.

Both parties file respective haziras.

Heard both sides.

Ld advocate for the petitioner submitted that the date of marriage between the parties and the date of separation between the parties mentioned in the petition u/s. 125 of CrPC are wrong and petitioner has sought for amendment of those two dates.

On the other hand ld advocate for the OP has raised strong objection to the petition and submitted that the mistakes were intentional and so amendment cannot be allowed. Ld advocate further submitted that the petitioner has mentioned the same date of marriage in the FIR lodged by her against the OP and his family members.

Perused the petition and materials on record.

The petitioner has filed her affidavit on assets and liabilities in this case where she has mentioned her date of marriage as 18.02.2019 and date of separation as 15.11.2020. An elaborate hearing was held during the hearing the interim maintenance petition. But the petitioner raised objection to the contention of the OP that the marriage took place on 26.02.2020 and the date of separation is 24.07.2020. Now all on a sudden the petitioner has filed this petition praying for correction of her date of marriage and date of separation. Petitioner has not disclosed as to how the mistake was done or as to how she finds out her mistake. It appears from her affidavit of assets of liabilities that the petitioner has studied upto HS. In such circumstance I have failed to understand as to how the petitioner has done the mistake and as to whether the mistake is intentional or not.

In such circumstance I am inclined to reject the amendment petition filed by the petitioner.
