Today is fixed for order.

Both parties are present by filing hazira.

It appears from the record that the petitioner filed her petition claiming maintenance for herself.

The OP being the husband of the petitioner is bound to maintain his wife.

Neither party filed any document of the income of the OP. Both parties made allegations and counter allegations which cannot be decided at this stage without recording evidence. In view of the economic condition of our country, it can be said that a person can earn Rs. 9,000/- to Rs. 10,000/- per month by working as a labour in different private organization or in Govt scheme. Therefore the OP can earn said amount by running small business.

Considering the above discussion, I am inclined to allow the petitioner's petition and in view of the present economic condition of our country, if the opposite party be directed to pay Rs.2500/- per month for the petitioner as interim maintenance, none will be prejudiced.

Hence it is,

**ORDERED**

That the interim maintenance petition of the petitioner is hereby allowed.

The petitioner is entitled to get Rs. 2500/- per month for herself, as interim maintenance from the opposite party from the date of filing of the case.

The opposite party is directed to pay **Rs. 2500/- per month to the petitioner** as interim maintenance, month by month, within 7<sup>th</sup> day of each succeeding English calendar month from the date of filing of the case till disposal of the case. In default, the petitioner is at liberty to realize the same through court.

Let a copy of this order be given to the petitioner free of cost.
