Today is fixed for SA.

Complainant is present with his Advocate on record.

Record shows that no witnesses including complainant is examined u/s. 223 of BNSS.

In view of guidelines laid down by the **Hon'ble High Court at Calcutta recently in CRR 119 of 2025 dated 18/07/2025**, I am of the view that in order to avoid undue delay notice needs to issued to the proposed accused persons at once.

After hearing the proposed accused persons, the next proceeding u/s 223 of BNSS shall be taken.

In the meantime, the Complainant is directed to file requisites.

The Notice should explicitly mention the following points,

- That the Complaint is filed against you and that you can appear in person or through your Advocate for the purpose of Hearing at Pre-Cognizance stage,
- That you have a right to avail free legal aid, if eligible, in term of Legal Services Authorities Act, 1987,

To 18-11-2025 for SR of Notice.
