Today is fixed for passing order.

The application for interim maintenance is taken up for passing order.

Perused the petition, the WO and other materials on record and documents filed by the parties.

It appears from the record that the petitioner filed her petition claiming maintenance for herself and for her minor son.

The OP being the husband of the petitioner and father of her child is bound to maintain his wife and minor child.

Neither party filed any document of the income of the OP. In view of the economic condition of our country, it can be said that a person can earn Rs.8000/- to Rs. 9000/- per month by working as a labour in different private organization or in Govt scheme or even by running small business. Therefore the OP can earn said amount even by working as labour.

Considering the above discussion, I am inclined to allow the petitioner's petition and in view of the present economic condition of our country, if the opposite party be directed to pay Rs.2500/- per month for the petitioner and Rs. 1500/- per month for the minor daughter of the petitioner, hence total Rs. 4000/- per month, as interim maintenance, none will be prejudiced.

Hence it is,

**ORDERED**

That the interim maintenance petition of the petitioner is hereby allowed.

The petitioner is entitled to get Rs. 2500/- per month for herself and Rs. 1500/- per month for the minor daughter of the petitioner, **hence total Rs. 4000/- per month**, as interim maintenance from the opposite party from the date of filing of the case.

The opposite party is directed to pay **Rs. 2500/- per month for the petitioner and Rs. 1500/- per month for the minor daughter of the petitioner, hence total Rs. 4000/- per month** to the petitioner as interim maintenance, month by month, within 7<sup>th</sup> day of each succeeding English calendar month from this date of filing of the case till disposal of the case. In default, the petitioner is at liberty to realize the same through court.

Let a copy of this order be given to the petitioner free of cost.
