On consent of both the parties, the record is taken up for hearing temporary injunction petition.

Considered.

This is a suit for partition and injunction.

It appears from the record that this court vide order no. 02 dated 27.09.2010 passed an order of ad interim injunction directing to the plaintiff and the defendant to maintain status in respect of the regarding nature and character and the said order was extended from time to time.

Considering the entire facts and circumstances and the prima facie case made out by the plaintiff to go for the trial, and balance of convenience and inconvenience, irreparable loss and injury, I am of the view that in order to protect the suit property the said order of ad interim injunction is required to be made absolute till the disposal of the suit.

Accordingly, the prayer for temporary injunction filed by the plaintiff is considered and allowed on contest without any costs.

Hence, it is,

**ordered**

Both the plaintiff and defendant no. 1 are directed to maintain status quo in respect of the suit property regarding its nature and character till disposal of the suit.

The petition for extension of ad-interim injunction is thus disposed of, accordingly.
