Ankita Vs. State of Punjab

ORDER:

1. Notice of the instant bail application under Section 482 of BNSS, filed on behalf of the applicant Ankita, was given to the State. Reply to the bail application, has not been filed. ASI Tajinder Singh No.191, Police Station Nangal appeared on behalf of the Police Station Nangal.
2. Vide present order, instant anticipatory bail application under Section 482 of BNSS, filed on behalf of the applicant-accused Ankita, is being disposed of.
3. It is averred in the bail application that a person namely Jaspreet Singh had given one false application against the applicant to the DSP Nangal by leveling false and baseless allegations. The applicant is

innocent lady and has committed no offence. The applicant has recently delivered a baby and her health condition is not good. The applicant is ready to join the investigation. Nothing is to be recovered from the applicant. With these averments, a prayer for allowing the instant bail application, has been made.

4. ASI Tajinder Singh No.191/R appeared and has made a statement in the Court that FIR No.138 dated 24.10.2024 under Section 318(4), 3(5) of BNS has been registered at Police Station Nangal against the accused Anil Kumar son of Jagmohan Singh, resident of Hill View near Sharma Store, Nangal, Ankita Sharma (applicant herein) daughter of Sham Lal, resident of Mojjowal wife of Balwinder Kumar, resident of House No.52-B, Sector 2, New Nangal, Anuj Kumar resident of Delhi and Kushal Kumar resident of Jalandhar.

5. The Learned Counsel for the applicant has submitted that the applicant has been falsely implicated in the FIR mentioned above. The Learned Counsel has submitted that the applicant is innocent therefore, the present bail application may be allowed.

6. On the other hand, the Learned Addl. PP for the State has submitted that the applicant has filed the blanket bail application whereas as per the statement of ASI Tajinder Singh, the applicant is arrayed as accused in FIR No.138 dated 24.10.2024 registered at Police Station Nangal against the applicant and other accused person. The Learned Counsel has submitted that the present anticipatory bail application is not maintainable, therefore, same may be dismissed.

7. I have heard the rival submissions and perused the record carefully.

8. The applicant Ankita has filed the blanket anticipatory bail application. Upon notice of the present bail application, ASI Tajinder Singh appeared and has made a statement in the Court that FIR No.138 dated 24.10.2024 under Section 318(4), 3(5) of BNS has been registered at Police Station Nangal against the accused Anil Kumar, Ankita Sharma (applicant herein) daughter of Sham Lal, Anuj Kumar and Kushal Kumar. Since, the applicant has been nominated as accused in the above-said FIR No.138 dated 24.10.2024, therefore, the instant blanket bail application filed by the applicant-accused Ankita, is not maintainable and the same is hereby accordingly dismissed.

9. Papers of this bail application be consigned to the Judicial Record Room, Rupnagar after due compliance.
