ORDER:

This order shall dispose of present application for bail
filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C by applicant Sandeep Singh @
Gopi, in the above noted FIR.

2. Learned counsel for applicant has argued that
applicant is in custody since 04.12.2018. He further argued that

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completion of trial shall take long time, therefore no purpose would be served by keeping the accused behind the bars. He further argued that other co-accused are on bail in the connected trial. With these submissions, he prayed for grant of concession of regular bail.

3. Per contra, learned Addl. PP for the State has argued that there are serious allegations against the applicant, therefore he is not entitled for the concession of bail. With these submissions, he prayed for dismissal of the application.

4. I have heard the rival contentions of both the sides and have perused the record.

5. In the present case, the allegations against the applicant are that on 28.09.2017, applicant alongwith other co-accused laid seize of complainant and his friend Surjit Singh. The accused attacked the complainant and caused injuries to him and thereafter snatched Rs.850/- alongwith mobile phone from the complainant and his friend Surjit Singh. The supplementary challan has been presented in this Court as he was declared proclaimed offender. The completion of trial will take long time to conclude. Keeping in view the entire circumstances, of the case, the applicant is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds in the sum of Rs.50,000/- one surety in the like amount subject to the conditions:-

1. That the applicant will appear before the Court on each and every date.

2. That applicant will not leave the country without prior permission of the Court, and

3. That applicant will not threaten or induce any witnesses to dissuade him from disclosing the true facts.

6. Accordingly, the present bail application is hereby allowed. Record be returned. Bail application file be tagged with the main file.
