ORDER

1. The instant application preferred U/s 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sahnita, 2023 for the grant of anticipatory bail.
2. It is alleged in the bail application that applicant is law abiding citizen. It is also alleged that applicant is innocent person and he has not committed any offence. It is also alleged that few days ago, the aforesaid police department has called the applicant and when the applicant asked for reason, then no satisfactory reply was given but the police told him that one girl who is daughter of Kuldeep Singh alongwith her father gave an

application against him from where the applicant came to know that he is unnecessarily harassed by one person namely Kuldeep Singh. The reason behind that harassment is that Kuldeep Singh is married to a woman namely Mandeep Kaur who is extremely mentally harassed by Kuldeep Singh on pretext of bringing less dowry and extreme assault under the influence of liquor. Due to which, finally Mandeep Kaur filed one Domestic Violence Case against her husband Kuldeep Singh at Ludhiana in which three minor children are also in the care and custody of Mandeep Kaur. It is pertinent to mention here that Mandeep Kaur and the applicant are simply known to each other due to which the applicant little bit helped the Mandeep Kaur in her tough time due to which Kuldeep Singh having grudge with the applicant and considered that applicant is the person who supported Mandeep Kaur for filing cases against him. Few days ago when the elder daughter of Mandeep Kaur was captured by Mandeep Kaur while doing chat on instagram with some unknown boy then Mandeep Kaur became very much worried then when she inquired the matter then she came to know that her elder minor daughter of age about 16 years namely Lovepreet Kaur is engaged with one boy Ajay who is just residing adjoining the house of Mandeep Kaur at Ludhiana. After getting clarified about the above said fact, Mandeep Kaur tried to make Lovepreet Kaur understand that the time going on is very bad and further told to Lovepreet Kaur to mend her lifestyle being mother due to which Lovepreet Kaur became annoyed and finally run away from Ludhiana and reached to his father Kuldeep Singh. It is pertinent to mention here that Kuldeep Singh is very clever and bad person who by using the minor daughter Lovepreet Kaur just as a tool for leveling the score

with the applicant gave false application against the applicant through her daughter. The above mentioned facts are totally based upon true story in which Mandeep Kaur is also witness as she is totally aware about what is happening with the applicant inspite without any fault. Kuldeep Singh trying to impose the applicant in some serious false case just with the help of his minor daughter. The applicant is attaching the complete details of the application, Domestic Violence case filed by Mandeep Kaur along with her minor children against Kuldeep Singh for which Kuldeep Singh considered that applicant is reason behind the case, which is totally false. The applicant is having apprehension that he would be involved in some false case and would be harassed and pressurized by the police. The applicant is ready to join the investigation as and when required by this court. Hence, this bail application.

3. Upon notice of bail application, report from office of DSP (Crime against Women and Children) received in which it is stated as per their record, one complaint bearing No.673-PC-7/26 dated 30.04.2026 was moved by Kuldeep Singh son of Joginder Singh resident of village Noopur Machhiwara, District Moga against the applicant Sukhwinder Singh for molestation of his minor daughter. The said complaint is still pending for investigation.

4. Report from the police station City Moga was also received in which it is stated that as per their record, neither any complaint is pending against the applicant nor any case has been registered against him.

5. Since, no FIR is stated to have been registered against the applicant, as such, the present application seeking anticipatory bail is not

maintainable. Hence, the present anticipatory bail application is hereby dismissed. However, in case of the arrest of applicant in the event of registration of FIR against him on the basis of complaint bearing No.673-PC-7/26 dated 30.04.2026 was moved by Kuldeep Singh son of Joginder Singh, the police will follow guidelines as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in case titled as **Arnesh Kumar Vs. State of Bihar and another, AIR 2014 SC 2756**. File be consigned to the Record Room.
