

Jarnail Singh Vs. State,
BA No. 1579 of 2018,

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ORDER

Police file received.

2. Heard on bail application filed under section 438(i) Cr.P.C
by applicant/accused Jarnail Singh son of Dalip Singh, in FIR No. 170
dated 05.07.2018, Police Station Sadar Ferozepur, under sections 15,
18, 21, 22, 66-C, 8-A(a), 61 NDPS Act and 25/27 Arms Act.

3. On 05.07.2018, Inspector Gurwinder Singh sent ruqa to
the police station to the effect that he alongwith other police officials
was present at main chowk of Village Dulchi Ke and received secret
information that Amrik Singh and Jarnail Singh indulge in sale of
heroin, opium etc. at a big scale. With drug money, they have
purchased many properties in Ferozepur and in different villages. In
case raid is conducted, heavy quantity of intoxicant, illegal weapons,
vehicles and other documents can be recovered. On the basis of this
ruqa, FIR was registered. Raid was thereafter, conducted. 20 sale deeds

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of different properties, one i-20 car, 3 revolvers and 1 rifle alongwith cartridges were recovered.

4. Shri AS Kamboj Advocate, assisted by Shri IS Ghallu Advocate has argued that accused is innocent. He has been falsely implicated due to political vendetta. A case regarding Lambardari of the Village is pending before Commissioner, Ferozepur. Weapons recovered are licenced one. Properties were purchased by the applicant with his own money, earned from agriculture produce etc. as he is owner of 23 acres of land. No property purchased prior to 6 years can be forfeited, as per law. He is ready to surrender and join investigation. He should be granted bail.

5. On the other hand, learned Additional Public Prosecutor has argued that applicant/accused Jarnail Singh alongwith his son Amrik Singh had been indulging in sale of intoxicant at big scale. With drug money, they have purchased several properties. 20 sale deeds of different properties have been recovered. One car and 4 weapons have already been recovered. Thorough investigation is to be done in the matter, for which custodial interrogation of the accused is required. He has argued for dismissal of the bail application.

6. I have considered respective submissions and have gone through the file.

7. As per allegations, applicant/accused Jarnail Singh and his son/co-accused Amrik Singh had been indulging in sale of intoxicant and with such drug money, they have made huge wealth. 20 sale deeds of different properties, one car, fire arms etc. have already been recovered. Further recoveries of movable and immovable properties are to be effected from the accused, procured by them with such drug money. Custodial interrogation of the accused may be required for the same. No case is made out for grant of anticipatory bail to the applicant/accused. As such, bail application is dismissed. Police record be returned. File be consigned to record room.
