**ORDER**

This order of mine shall dispose of two applications for regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C moved by accused/applicants Rajesh Sharma and Reetu Sharma in case FIR No. 44 dated 09.02.2024 for offence under Sections 384, 420, 120-B, 506 of IPC, PS Rama Mandi, District Jalandhar.

2. Relevant facts for disposal of bail application are that Sucha Singh son of Darshan being SHO of PS Rama Mandi alongwith other police officials were present in connection with patrol duty near Krishna Sweet Shop, Jalandhar, when secret informer given information that Dharminder Gill, Preet Kaur alias Preet, Mohini, Amandeep alongwith other persons have formed a gang and these girls are involved in cheating to the innocent people by entangling them for their love. The girls by taking innocent people in the hotel and then develop physical relations with them and prepare video in the mobile phones and then extort money by calling their relatives and moving false complaint to the police. On the basis of these allegations, case has been got registered and investigation is pending.

3. Learned counsel for the applicants/accused pressed for regular bail on the ground that accused/applicants have been falsely implicated merely on the basis of secret information and there is no complainant in this case. Learned counsel for accused/applicants further pressed that accused/applicants were arrested on 09.02.2024 and they are in custody for the last more than one and half months, whereas alleged

offences are triable by the court of learned JMIC. Learned counsel for accused/applicants further argued that presentation of challan and conclusion of trial would take long time and prayed for bail on these grounds.

4. Learned Addl.P.P for the State opposed the bail applications on the ground that accused/applicants alongwith other co-accused were cheating to the innocent people and prayed for dismissal of bail applications.

5. I have heard learned counsel for the accused/applicants as well as Public Prosecutor for the State and perused the record carefully.

6. After giving my anxious thoughts to their rival submissions and perusal of record reveals the facts that police has got registered the case on the basis of secret information, but no complainant has revealed these allegations before the police. Accused/applicants have been arrested on 09.02.2024 and they are in custody since then. The completion of investigation, presentation of challan and conclusion of trial would take long time, whereas allegations levelled by secret informer have yet to be proved during trial and all the alleged offences are triable by court of learned JMIC, therefore, no useful purpose would be served by detaining the accused/applicants into custody for an indefinite period as pretrial detention would never be considered in the interest of justice. Keeping in view of these facts and circumstances, instant bail applications are hereby allowed and accused-applicants **Rajesh Kumar and Reetu Sharma** are ordered to be released on bail on furnishing of bail bonds in the sum of

Rs.30,000/-each with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of learned Area Magistrate/Ld. Duty Magistrate.

7. However, any observation given in this order shall not effect on merits of the main case. Police record be returned. Copy of order be placed in the connected bail application. Attested copy of this order be sent to the court of learned Area Magistrate for compliance. Police record be returned, whereas bail application file be consigned to the record room after due compilation.
