ORDER

Bail application put up before the undersigned being
Judge on Duty.

2. Present petition has been filed by petitioner seeking
regular bail under Section 439 of Cr.P.C. for the alleged commission
of offence as mentioned above.

3. Upon notice, learned Additional P.P put in appearance
and contested the bail application. Police record was requisitioned
and perused.

4. I have heard learned counsel for petitioner as well as

learned Additional Public Prosecutor for State and also perused the record.

5. The case of the prosecution is that on 25/09/2021, in the area of T point of Grain Market Qadian, 460 intoxicating tablets of white color without label were recovered from petitioner. He was arrested and since then, he is in custody.

6. Petitioner is in custody since 25.09.2021 for the alleged recovery of 460 intoxicating tablets. The challan in this case has already been presented. As per FSL report, the recovered intoxicating tablets contained Tramadol Hydrochloride (165.8 grams) which falls in the category of non commercial quantity. The disposal of trial shall take sufficient long time and no purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner behind the bars for indefinite period. As such, present application is hereby allowed and petitioner is admitted to regular bail on his furnishing bail bonds in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with one surety in the like amount subject to the following conditions:-

- i. That he will appear in the court on each and every date of hearing;
- ii. That he will not leave the country without prior permission of the Court;
- iii. That he will not make any threat, promise or inducement to any person conversant with the facts of the case to dissuade him/her from disclosing the truth to the Court or police;
