- 1) Today is fixed for hearing of the applications filed on behalf of the accused Bipul Saha on 14.07.2026.
- 2) The Learned PP-in-Charge is present along with the Case Diary.
- 3) The Learned Lawyer appearing for the accused has also filed a fresh application praying for bail on behalf of the accused Bipul Saha.
- 4) The record is taken up for hearing. Heard the Learned Lawyers appearing for the respective parties.
- 5) The materials available in the Case Diary have been carefully perused.
- 6) Learned Lawyer for the accused/petitioner submits that his client has been languishing in Judicial Custody since 20.05.2026 and has been falsely implicated in the present case.
- 7) Per contra, the Learned PP-in-Charge has drawn the attention of this Court to the nature and quantity of the contraband allegedly recovered from the conscious possession of the accused/petitioner, namely, **691 bottles of cough syrup** containing Codeine Phosphate.
- 8) The investigation is still proceeding in full swing.
- 9) This Court cannot remain unmindful of the pernicious scourge of narcotic trafficking, which strikes at the very vitals of society. The gravity of such offences warrants heightened judicial circumspection in matters of bail.
- 10) No material has been brought on record to satisfy the twin conditions engrafted under Section 37 of the NDPS Act. The statutory embargo, therefore, remains undiluted and constitutes an insuperable impediment to the grant of bail.
- 11) Accordingly, the prayer for bail stands rejected.
- 12) Let the matter be fixed on **28.07.2026** (todate) for production of the accused and for submission of the IO's report in final form.
- 13) CD be returned.
