ORDER

1. Heard on the second bail application dated 14.01.2026 filed through learned counsel on the basis of power of attorney executed by the accused/applicant namely Bhupinder Singh along with affidavit of the accused/applicant.
2. Notice of the bail application was issued to the State through Ld. Addl. PP, who put in appearance and contested bail application. He didn't file any reply to the bail application rather submitted that he will orally argue the matter. The file was summoned as challan was presented.
3. I have heard Ld. Addl. PP for the State and Ld. Counsel for bail-applicant and have gone through the police record.

4. From material placed on record, it comes out to surface that the accused Bhupinder Singh was apprehended on 09.06.2025 with 37 gram intoxicant powder and Rs.3000/- drug money. After completing the necessary formalities, the FIR was registered.

5. The bail-applicant was arrested on 09.06.2025 and since then he is custody. The report of Forensic Science Laboratory has been received. The challan in this case was presented on 16.10.2025. Charge against accused-applicant was framed on 03.01.2026, after receipt of FSL report. The salt of intoxicant powder was found to be Tramadol Hydrochloride and it came out to be 37 gram, which is non-commercial. Now the case is fixed for 30.01.2026 for evidence of the prosecution.

6. The trial will take time and no useful purpose will be served by keeping him confined. Therefore, this Court deems it proper to grant regular bail to bail-applicant on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with one surety of the like amount to the satisfaction of Illaqa Magistrate/Duty Magistrate with the following conditions:

- a) That accused shall attend the Court on each and every date of hearing;
- b) That accused shall not commit an offence similar to the offence of which he/she is accused, or suspected, of the commission of which he/she is suspected;
- c) That accused shall not directly or indirectly make an inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him/her from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer or tamper with the evidence; and

- d) That accused shall not leave the country without prior permission of Court.

7. The observation made by undersigned vide this order shall not be construed as reflection of mind on merits. Bail application file be attached with the main case file.
