In view of the Hon'ble High Court Letter No. B(Gen)-1001/2024/1554, dated 22.08.2024, for undertaking special drive, the instant matter is taken up on today's board.

2. The accused is charge sheeted for the offence punishable under Sections 5 and 7 of the Cigarettes and Other Tobacco Products Act. The present case is inherently summons case. The procedure of summary trial is prescribed for the instant case.

3. In the present case, the charge sheet is presented on 26.10.2020. On perusal of record it appears that, several times summons are issued to the accused but the prosecution failed to secure his presence. Hence, it appears that no fruitful purpose will be served by keeping the matter pending on the file of the Court. Thus, the proceeding is hereby stopped under Section 258 of the Code of Criminal Procedure and the accused is entitled for discharge. Hence, I proceed to pass following order:

ORDER

1. The proceeding is hereby stopped vide Section 258 of the Code of Criminal Procedure and the accused is discharged.
2. The bail bonds of the accused, if any, stands cancelled.
3. The case papers be filed.
