This application for anticipatory bail u/s 482 of B.N.S.S filed on behalf of present petitioners **1. Rajesh Layek, 2. Sintu Layek @ Manoj Layek & 3. Rina Layek** in connection with Goalpokher P.S. Case No.47/2026 dated 08.02.2026 vide GR 314/2026 u/s 85/329(4)/115(2)/109(1)/74/303(2)/351(2)/3(5) B.N.S is taken up for hearing.

Learned Advocate for the petitioners by filing an affidavit submits that no such application under section 482 of B.N.S.S is either rejected or pending in this Court or before the Hon'ble Higher Courts prior to this application.

On query, Ld. Public Prosecutor submits that there is no reflection in the CD that there is any bail application either pending or rejected by the Hon'ble Higher Courts and IO also did not intimate him that any bail application is pending or rejected by the Hon'ble Higher Courts.

Ld Advocate for the petitioners submits that the husband of the victim has died. These petitioners are the in-laws of the victim. Ld Advocate further submitted that from the FIR, it would appear that the primary allegation is of torture. There is no such material to attract the provision of sec.109 B.N.S. Ld Advocate accordingly prayed for anticipatory bail on any condition.

Ld Public Prosecutor raised formal objection and left the matter to the discretion of the Court.

Perused the FIR and other relevant documents available in the case record. Perused the CD including statements of witnesses recorded u/s 180 B.N.S.S.

Considering the relevant documents as available in the CD and other facts and circumstances and keeping in mind that all the three petitioners are in-laws of the victim, I am of the view that custodial detention of the petitioners is not required in the interest of investigation. Accordingly, prayer for anticipatory bail u/s 482 of B.N.S.S is hereby considered and allowed.

Accused/Petitioners namely **1. Rajesh Layek, 2. Sintu Layek @ Manoj Layek & 3. Rina Layek**, in the event of arrest, in connection with Goalpokher P.S. Case No.47/2026 dated 08.02.2026 vide GR 314/2026, be released on furnishing bail bond of Rs.3,000/- each with one surety of like amount each, subject to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer. If on bail they shall comply with the provisions of section 482(2) of B.N.S.S.

Thus, the Criminal Misc Case is disposed of accordingly. Return LCR and CD.
