**COMMITAL ORDER**

The Police Sub Inspector of Govindapura. Police station, Bengaluru has submitted this charge-sheet against the accused for the offence punishable U/s 311 of BNS-2023.

**2. The brief facts of the case of the prosecution is that :-**

On 14.12.2024, at around 7:00 p.m., within the jurisdiction of Govindapur Police Station, while CW-1 was standing in front of H.M.S. Store, 13th Cross, Rashadanagar, Govindapur, the accused, riding a Red and Black TVS NTORQ Scooter, Reg. No. KA-33-EE-9959, approached CW-1 and blocked their way. The accused displayed a 5-inch dagger and an 8-inch iron knife, and assaulted CW-1 near the legs. Thereafter, the accused forcibly took possession of CW-1's Vivo V-28 mobile phone and Rs.4,000/- cash, and fled from the spot. Hence, this charge-sheet.

**3.** The investigation Officer during the investigation has arrested the accused and produced before the court and is remanded to Judicial custody and is produced before the court from judicial custody and accused is represented by his counsel.

**4.** The charge-sheet and other prosecution papers have been furnished to the accused through his counsel as contemplated U/s 230 of BNSS.

5. Perused the charge-sheet and other prosecution papers filed by the investigation officer. The prosecution papers discloses that, the alleged offence U/s 311 of BNS-2023. It appears to me that, alleged offences against the accused U/s 311 of BNS-2023., which is exclusively triable before the Hon'ble Court of Sessions. The prosecution papers at this stage has made out a prima-facie case against the accused for the alleged offences. As alleged offence is exclusively triable before the Hon'ble Court of Sessions, it is just and necessary to commit the case to court of sessions for trial. Accordingly, this court proceed to pass the following:-

**ORDER**

**A) Acting u/S.232 of BNSS., the case against the accused is committed to the Hon'ble Court of Sessions at Bengaluru for trial.**

**B) The accused is remanded to Judicial Custody during and until the conclusion of trial.**

**C) Office is directed to notify the committal order to the Learned Public**

**Prosecutor of the Hon'ble Court of Sessions  
at Bengaluru.**

**D) Office is hereby directed to submit  
entire case file and properties if any to the  
Hon'ble Court of Sessions at the earliest.**

**E) The Jail Authorities are hereby  
directed to produce the accused before  
Hon'ble Court of Sessions whenever called  
upon to do so, soon after receipt of  
intimation.**
