Regular P.O is on Spl. SIR duty.

I.O is present with PC report and CD.

Seen the forwarding report, accused challan and medical slips.

Ld. PP-in-charge is present and filed a petition u/s 37 of NDPS Act praying for rejection of bail.

Ld. Advocate for the accused persons is present.

Two separate bail petitions - one for accused **Rajib Chowdhury @ Raju** and another one for accused persons namely, **Tonmoy Laha @ Tonu and Tinku Abasthi @ Dingha** are filed.

Copy served.

The bail petition is moved for the accused persons.

Heard both sides.

Perused the case record and CD.

Ld. Advocate submitted that these accused persons are in custody since **08.03.2026**. The accused persons were taken into PC for two days and today they are produced before this Court. The allegations brought against the accused persons is fabricated. The accused persons are not involved in the offence. Ld. Advocate further submitted that during PC period, no fruitful result could be achieved. Ld. Advocate accordingly, prayed for allowing bail to the accused persons on any condition.

Ld. PP submitted that the seizure shows recovery of commercial quantity of 100 bottles of Triprolidine Hydrochloride & Codeine Phosphate Cough Syrup "PHENSECYL" each bottle containing 100 ml (total 100ml X 100=10,000 ml), which is of huge quantity. The case is at very early stage. The procedure of search and seizure has been properly performed. So, Ld. PP accordingly, prayed for rejection of bail petition.

After hearing of both sides and on perusal of the case record, it appears that the case involves recovery of commercial quantity of narcotic drugs. Moreover, this is no prima facie material to hold that this accused persons are in no way involved with the alleged offence. There is also no such material to hold that if the accused persons are granted bail, they shall not indulge into similar kind of offence.

In the circumstances, keeping in mind the bar u/s. 37 of NDPS Act, I am not inclined to allow the prayer for bail of the accused persons. Hence, the bail prayer of the accused persons namely, **Rajib Chowdhury @ Raju, Tonmoy Laha @ Tonu and Tinku Abasthi @ Dingha** stands rejected at this stage.
