ORDER:

1. Present application filed on behalf of applicant/accused Raj @ Raju seeking regular bail in the matter, details of which have been referred above, shall be disposed off through this order.
2. As per contents of FIR, on 23.04.2024 at about 9:00/9:15 PM complainant Karan Kumar alongwith son of his aunt namely Amarjeet Singh son of Joginder Singh proceeded from his house by foot for Mannewala railway crossing and when they reached on the turn, little

ahead of grocery store of Gurcharan Singh Fauji, two persons with muffled faces were standing there and when they reached near them, the aforesaid unidentified persons intercepted them and forcibly snatched purse containing Rs.25,00/- Adhaar card and slips from the complainant and when the said persons tried to run away, they were chased and apprehended by the complainant side and during scuffle, the clothes tied on the mouth of assailants opened, on which complainant identified the assailants as Sunil Kumar and Sajjan Singh. When the complainant tried to take his purse back from them, Raj @ Raju son of Kahmir Singh came on motorcycle from back and Akash son of Sohan Singh of their village also came. Raj Kumar @ Raju gave kirch blow to complainant which hit on forehead above left eye of complainant due to which blood started oozing from there and complainant fell down. Thereafter, Sunil Kumar and Sajjan Singh started beating Amarjeet Singh son of aunt of complainant. Raj Kumar @ Raju gave kirch blow to Amarjeet Singh which hit on his left cheek and nose. Then Akash Singh gave fist blow to Amarjeet Singh which hit on his upper lip. In the meantime, one other unidentified associate of the assailants came at the spot and started giving kick blows to complainant. On alarm being raised by the complainant and his cousin, the assailants threatened them to eliminate if they reported the matter to police. On seeing gathering, the assailants fled away from the spot. Initially, the complainant and his cousin were admitted at Civil Hospital, Jalalabad from where, they were referred to Guru Gobind Singh Medical College Faridkot. With these allegations, the present FIR was

registered against the applicant-accused and others.

3. Notice of the bail application was served upon the State through learned Additional PP alongwith copy of bail application, who received the same, appeared and contested the bail application on merits. Police record was requisitioned which has been received and perused.

4. I have heard the respective contentions of both the learned Advocates and have perused the record with their able assistance.

5. The allegations against the applicant-accused are to the effect that he gave kirch blow on the person of complainant and absconded. The applicant-accused is in custody since long. There are no prior antecedents of the accused. Learned counsel for the applicant-accused pointed out that he has been falsely implicated in this case by the police. Now without commenting on the merits of the case and keeping in view the above stated facts, this court is of the view that the indefinite custody of the applicant-accused would not serve any useful purpose as such, the bail application stands allowed. The applicant is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of the learned Illaqa Magistrate/Duty Magistrate subject to the following conditions :-

- A. *That the applicant shall appear before the Trial Court on each and every date of hearing.*
- B. *That the applicant shall not directly or indirectly induce or coerce any witness of prosecution so as to dissuade him from deposing as witness in the Court.*
- C. *That the applicant shall not leave India without prior permission of the Court.*

Police record be returned and the file of bail application be
consigned to the record room.
