This application for bail u/s 483 of B.N.S.S filed on behalf of present accused/petitioner **Sanjoy Barman** in connection with Kaliyaganj P.S. Case No.493/2025 dated 09.12.2025 vide GR 3185/2025 u/s 309(6)/312/109(1)/238(b)/324(5)/121(1)/351(2)/3(5) B.N.S r/w sec. 25/27 Arms Act & adding sec. 310(4)/317(3) B.N.S.S. is taken up for hearing.

Learned Advocate for the accused/petitioner by filing an affidavit submits that no such application u/s 483 of B.N.S.S is pending in this Court or before the Hon'ble Higher Courts prior to this application.

On query, Ld. Public Prosecutor submits that there is no reflection in the CD that there is any bail application either pending or rejected by Hon'ble Higher Courts and IO also did not intimate him that any bail application is pending or rejected by Hon'ble Higher Courts.

Ld Advocate for the accused/petitioner submits that this accused was arrested in connection with this case on 10.12.2025. Since that time, he is in custody. There is allegation in the FIR that this accused had tried to break open ATM machine and commit theft of cash. Ld Advocate further submitted that the process of search and seizure is already over and further detention of this accused in custody is not required in the interest of investigation. Ld Advocate accordingly prayed for bail on any condition.

Ld Public Prosecutor raised objection and submitted that this is a case of organized crime. Many persons are involved in the alleged incident. This accused was apprehended at the time of attempting to commit robbery by breaking open the ATM machine. They have also caused theft of a genuine number plate of a person's vehicle and they have used such number plate with their own vehicle while committing this offence. Ld PP further submitted that if this accused is granted bail at this stage, he will surely abscond and thereby the entire trial will be jeopardized. Ld PP accordingly prayed for rejection of bail.

I have perused the FIR and other relevant materials available in the case record. I have perused the charge sheet from which it appears that there is prima facie materials that have been collected against this accused along with other accused persons.

Perused the CD from which it can be found that the investigation has been done in an organized manner and there is prima facie evidence to consider that this accused is involved in commission of an organized crime.

Considering present facts and circumstances, I am of the view that if this accused is granted bail, there is every possibility that he will try to evade the trial.

Considering the same, I am not inclined to allow the prayer for bail at this stage. Accordingly, prayer for bail u/s 483 B.N.S.S of accused/petitioner **Sanjoy Barman** stands **rejected**.

Thus, the Criminal Misc Case is disposed of accordingly. Return LCR & CD.
