Heard arguments of both sides. <u>ORDER PASSED ON EXH.01:</u> By this application, applicant/accused Srinivasa Rao Mylapalli prayed for grant of twelve weeks time to furnish surety and till then, to be released on provisional cash bail. 2. Learned SPP for CBI strongly opposed the application. 3. Heard both sides. 4. On 23.06.2025, bail application filed by applicant/accused Srinivasa Rao Mylapalli came to be allowed by this Court and applicant has been released on bail on furnishing PB. and cash security of Rs.2,00,000/-. Difficulty is submitted by applicant in furnishing surety bond on today itself, which found proper. It is matter of the fact and common knowledge that in the city of Mumbai, it is time consuming to procure surety of Rs.2,00,000/-. Hence, time is required to complete said procedure. So also, there is no material brought on record by the prosecution to refuse the request of applicant. Resultantly, by keeping conditions intact as imposed in bail application, time is granted to applicant/accused to furnish surety. Hence, order: <u>ORDER</u> 1. Provisionally, accused Srinivasa Rao Mylapalli is hereby permitted to be released on cash bail on depositing cash security of Rs.2,00,000/- (Rupees Two Lakhs only) with P. R. Bond of like amount. 2. Period of Three Weeks to furnish the surety is granted. 3. Accordingly, CBI Misc. Application No.858 of 2025 stands disposed of. SPL. JUDGE
