Ld. Advocates of both sides are present.

An adjournment petition is filed from the end of the petitioner.

Ld. advocate for the OP draws the attention of the Ld. Court that since a long period of time stretching to almost 2 ½ years, the OP being the father of the child has not been able to have any access to his daughter. Such a circumstance has caused deep pain and anguish in the mind of the OP and has occasioned the deprivation of his right as the father to enjoy the comfort of the company and affection of his daughter. By placing forth this submission, Ld. Advocate for the OP has prayed for an order from the Ld. Court which will facilitate and devise a mechanism for the OP to have access to his daughter in whatever form which is deemed fit by the Ld. Court.

Ld. Advocate for the petitioner does not stand in the way of the relief sought for by the OP and leaves the matter to be considered by the Ld. Court through the wisdom and judicial conscience.

On giving a deep attention to the submissions advanced from both sides and after appreciation of all the relevant factors which are associated to the development of the child, both mentally and physically, I feel that an arrangement can be devised to ensure the enjoyment of the company of his daughter by the OP till the Ld.Court takes up the parent application for custody to adjudicate the same.

The child is presently residing at the house of the petitioner and this fact of residence of the child enjoins upon me to work out an arrangement, so that the child can meet her father without facing any hurdle and inconvenience in any manner whatsoever and to me such an arrangement can be best made if the opposite party is permitted to have access to his child namely Anayka Adhikary on the digital platform. By toeing in this line, I permit the opposite party to have access to his child as named above through the digital platform by way of a *WhatsApp* call and the opposite party will be permitted to

make such a call to his daughter from 06:30 p.m to 07:30 p.m on every Wednesday and Saturday in a week. The petitioner being the maternal grandfather is directed to ensure that the child is able to communicate with the opposite party being the father during such call. This arrangement will remain in force till the next date of hearing.

The prayer for adjournment petition filed from the end of petitioner is considered and allowed.

As the Ld. Advocates of both sides are present, so they are requested to communicate this order to their respective clients for due compliance.
