Today is fixed for production, IO's report and CD.
Accused Tilak Bhuiya is produced from J/C physically.
Bail petition is filed for accused Tilak Bhuiya.
Copy of bail petition served upon Ld. PP in charge.
Ld. PP in charge is present.

It is submitted by the Ld. Advocate appearing for the accused that no bail application is pending u/s.439 of Cr.P.C in respect of the present accused person in any higher forum.

The Ld. Advocate for accused person submits that accused is languishing in jail custody on and from 13.03.2022 and he has falsely implicated in this case. He further submits that no narcotic substance was seized from the possession of present accused. According to him, accused is a permanent resident within the jurisdiction of this court and there is no chance of his abscondence, if he is released on bail. For the reasons stated above, he prays for releasing the accused on bail on any terms and conditions.

On the other hand Ld. PP in charge raises objection regarding the release of the accused on bail and files objection u/s.37 of NDPS Act.
CD is produced.

I have perused the CD and other materials on record. On perusal of the materials available in the CD prima facie it goes to show that seizure of 1400 bottles of Phensedyl containing condeine phosphate was seized and recovered from the physical possession of accused. Considering the same, I am not inclined to release the accused person on bail. Accordingly, prayer for bail of accused is hereby rejected.
