Accused Hussan Ali is brought under arrest on strength of W/A and WP & A issued by this court.

The accused chalan, arrest memo along with e-mail copy of forwarding letter and all the xerox copy of W/A and WP & A with e-mail copy of report signed by one SI of Police of Islampur PS in which it is stated that police of Islampur PS received the xerox copy of W/A from the SP Office, Islampur Police District with the endorsement of Superintendent of Police, Islampur Police District. Original W/A not yet received by the Islampur PS.

Accused Hussan Ali is taken into custody and remanded to J/C.

It is further directed to IC, Islampur PS to return the original W/A and WP & A to this court after collecting the same from SP Office so that it cannot be misused in future.

Two bail petition is filed along with two fresh Vokatnama on behalf of this accused.

Ld. Advocate Pratap Kar appears and moves the bail application. Another bail application with Vokatnama in favour of Ld. Advocate Subhajit Dey be ignored.

Ld. Advocate for accused person moves the bail application by submitting that his client is innocent, nothing has been recovered from his possession, his name has been transpired in charge sheet. If he is allowed on bail then he will face the trial.

Ld. PP in charge strongly raises objection by submitting inter alia that this accused is long absconding and his name has been transpired in other witnesses in case diaries and there is a materials against him in case diary and that is why charge sheet has been submitted against him.

Having heard both sides. Having perused the case record and case diary.

It appears that W/A & WP & A were issued against this accused person.

Considering the nature of allegation and nature of absconding, the bail prayer at this stage stands rejected.
