Having perused the case record, it appears that BSF personnel caught this accused in red handed and from his possession in total 1400 bottles of Phensedyl was recovered which was kept in a conceal manner with khad for cultivation in his agricultural land carried power tiller, land situates after crossing the Indo-Bangladesh fencing, with a view to smuggle the same to Bangladesh.

It is pertinent to state that the date for evidence has been going on by five consecutive dates.

Considering this fact, I am not inclined to allow his bail prayer as Sec.37 of Act is a bar and the same stands rejected.
