Today is fixed for production and IO's report.
Accused Tilak Bhuiya is produced from J/C physically.
Bail petition is filed for accused Tilak Bhuiya.
Copy of bail petition served upon Ld. PP in charge.
Ld. PP in charge is present.

The Ld. Advocate for accused person submits that accused has falsely implicated in this case. He further submits that no narcotic substance was seized from the possession of accused. According to him, accused is a permanent resident within the jurisdiction of this court and there is no chance of his abscondence, if he is released on bail. For the reasons stated above, he prays for releasing the accused on bail on any terms and conditions.

On the other hand Ld. PP in charge raises objection regarding the release of the accused on bail and files objection u/s.37 of NDPS Act.

On perusal of the record, I find that Commercial quantity of narcotic substance was seized and recovered from the possession of accused. As such, there is no scope to presume that accused is not guilty for committing the alleged offence. Accordingly, prayer for bail of accused is hereby rejected.
