The accused closed evidence in defence. Heard. Vide my separate judgment of the even date, the accused Darshan Singh Patwari is held guilty and convicted under Section 409/420/465/467/468/471 IPC. He is taken in custody and heard on the question of sentence.

Heard. The accused is held liable to undergo simple imprisonment for a period of three years and he is liable to pay fine in the sum of Rs.2000/- u/s 409 IPC. In default of payment of fine, he shall further undergo simple imprisonment for three months. Also the accused is held liable to undergo simple imprisonment for a period of three years and he is liable to pay fine in the sum of Rs.2000/- u/s 420 IPC. In default of payment of fine, he shall further undergo simple imprisonment for three months. Also the accused is held liable to undergo simple imprisonment for a period of two years and he is liable to pay fine in the sum of Rs.1000/- u/s 465 IPC. In default of payment of fine, he shall further undergo simple imprisonment for three months. Also the accused is held liable to undergo simple imprisonment for a period of three years and he is liable to pay fine in the sum of Rs.2000/- u/s 467 IPC. In default of payment of fine, he shall further undergo simple imprisonment for three months. Also the accused is held liable to undergo simple imprisonment for a period of three years and he is liable to pay fine in the sum of Rs.2000/- u/s 468 IPC. In default of payment of fine, he shall further undergo simple imprisonment for three months. Also the accused is held liable to undergo simple imprisonment for a period of two years and he is liable to pay fine in the sum of Rs.1000/- u/s 471 IPC. In default of payment of fine, he shall further undergo simple imprisonment for three months. Fine paid. All the sentences shall run concurrently. Period of custody if any undergone by the accused in the present case shall be set off from the substantive sentence imposed upon the accused. The bail/surety bonds of the accused stand discharged. Case property, if any be dealt with as per rules after the expiry of the period of appeal/revision if any.

An application has been filed on behalf of the accused for release of the accused on bail under Section 389 Cr.P.C. Since, the accused is convicted and is ordered to undergo simple imprisonment for a maximum

period of three years, he is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds in the sum of Rs.30,000/- with one surety in the like amount for a period of one month in order to apply for appeal. He is bound to produce the order vide which the sentence of the accused is stayed within a period of one month from today, failing which, he shall surrender before the Court and he shall be held liable to undergo the period of imprisonment. Bail/Surety bonds furnished, which are accepted, attested and found to be correct. File be consigned to record room. Application be put up on 09.12.2019.
