B A I L O R D E R :-

1. This order of mine shall dispose of the application for bail
under Section 438 Cr.P.C. of the applicant/accused Makhan Lal named
above, in a Criminal complaint case bearing Complaint No.
COMI/381/2017 titled as "**Chanchal Singh Vs Makhan Lal**" pending
before the court of Shri Ravinder Singh Rana, JMIC, Jalandhar in which

applicant/accused has been summoned to face trial under Sections 420, of IPC vide order dated 28.01.2021 passed by the Court of Shri Harshbir Sandhu, the then JMIC, Jalandhar.

2. Despite the issuance of notice, none has appeared on behalf of respondent/complainant to contest the bail application.

3. Learned counsel for the applicant/accused has submitted that the complainant has filed a false complaint. The applicant/accused has been summoned by the Court in a private complaint case and his custodial interrogation is not required. The applicant/accused is ready to face trial and further undertakes that he will abide by all the terms and conditions to be imposed by the Court, while granting bail to him. Accordingly, under these circumstances, it has been prayed that the bail application of the applicant/accused be allowed.

4. Lower Court record has been received and attached.

5. Perusal of record of learned lower Court shows that complainant Chanchal Singh has filed a complaint against present applicant/accused Makhan Lal under Section 420 of IPC, in which the learned trial Court, after appreciating the preliminary evidence led by the complainant, has summoned the applicant/accused vide order dated 28.01.2021 to face trial under the 420 of IPC. The applicant/accused has been summoned in a complaint case. The averments of the complaint are yet to be proved by way of evidence. No custodial interrogation of the

applicant/accused is required in the complaint case. The applicant/accused has undertaken in the application, to appear before the learned Trial Court on each and every date of hearing. Consequently, in view of the discussion made above, the bail application in hand is hereby **allowed** and the applicant/accused Makhan Lal is granted 15 days time from today to surrender in the Ld. Trial Court/Duty Magistrate and on his doing so, learned Trial Court/Duty Magistrate shall admit the applicant-accused Makhan Lal on bail to its satisfaction.

6. Lower Court record be returned immediately along with copy of this order for information and compliance. Record of this bail application be consigned to the Sessions Court record room after due compliance.
