An application has been moved by learned counsel for applicant for amendment of headnote and prayer clause of the bail application, with a prayer that sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC were inadvertently omitted to be mentioned in the headnote as well as in the prayer clause.

Notice of this application is given to learned Public Prosecutor for State, who is present in the Court today itself. Learned Public Prosecutor for State has not opposed this application.

Heard. Record perused. Perusal of the FIR reveals that in the FIR offences U/s 420, 465, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC have also been mentioned, however, in the bail application filed by applicant, these offences have been omitted by the applicant inadvertently.

Keeping in view the averments made in the application coupled with no objection by the learned Public Prosecutor, this application is allowed and disposed of. Amended bail application incorporating the above mentioned sections has been filed and the same be placed on record.

Learned counsel for applicant/accused made a request that learned Public Prosecutor be directed to file reply to this bail application, disclosing the entire facts, as to how applicant/accused is connected with the case in hand. Learned Public Prosecutor seeks short adjournment. Let reply, if any be filed by learned Public Prosecutor on 04.09.2020.
