ORDER:-

1. The present bail application under section 483 BNS has been moved by the applicant/accused in the aforesaid FIR, on the averments that accused/applicant could not appear before this Court on 16.10.2023 due to misunderstanding and her non bailable warrants was issued. Ultimately, she was declared as proclaimed offender vide order dated 04.12.2024. Thereafter, police arrested her on 14.06.2025 and since then

the accused/applicant is in judicial custody. It has been further averred that the absence of the accused/applicant was neither willful nor intentional. Therefore, prayer was made that the applicant/accused be released on bail.

2. Notice of the bail application was issued to the respondent State and learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State has contested the bail application on the ground that the accused has misused the concession of bail already granted to her and prayed for dismissal of the bail application. Main file has been received.

3. This Court has given thoughtful consideration to the rival contention made by both the parties and perused the record.

4. Perusal of the main file reveals that earlier accused/applicant Raj Kaur @ Rajjo was released on anticipatory bail vide order dated 26.02.2021 passed in BA No.278/2021. Thereafter, after the presentation of challan, repeatedly notices were issued to accused/applicant, but, she failed to turn up in the Court. On 16.10.2023, accused/applicant Raj Kaur @ Rajjo did not put appearance before the Court and her bail order, bail bonds and surety bonds were cancelled and forfeited to the State. Ultimately, vide order dated 04.12.2024, accused/applicant was declared as proclaimed person. On 14.06.2025, accused/applicant was rearrested and produced before the Court and since then she is in judicial custody in the present FIR. By this time, accused/applicant must have learnt a lesson for misusing the concession of bail in the present case. In context of the aforesaid facts and circumstances, without commenting on merits of the

case, bail application of applicant/accused Raj Kaur @ Rajjo stands **allowed**. Accused is admitted to bail on her furnishing personal bonds in the sum of Rs.60,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of learned Area/Duty Magistrate Court, subject to costs of Rs.7,000/- to be deposited in the District Legal Services Authorities, Kapurthala. In case the surety is not available, accused/applicant may submit FDR or cash security may also be deposited. Further conditions are.

1. That the applicant/accused shall attend the Court on each and every date of hearing in accordance with the bonds executed by him/her;
2. That the applicant/accused shall not leave India without prior permission of the court;
3. That the applicant/accused shall not tamper with the prosecution evidence.
4. Applicant/accused shall not directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him/her from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer;
5. Applicant/accused shall not commit an offence similar to the offence of which he/she is accused, or for the commission of which he/she suspected.

5. Copy of this order be sent to the learned Illaqa/Duty Magistrate forthwith under the signatures of Reader for compliance. The Court concerned is directed to send the bail bonds/surety bonds to this Court after acceptance of the same. A soft copy of the bail order be sent by e-mail to the accused/applicant through the Jail Superintendent forthwith. Accordingly, the present bail application stands allowed and disposed of. Record of this bail application be annexed with the main case file of present FIR.
