1. Bail application put up before me being Duty Judge in
view of order dated 30.3.2020 bearing No.2/SPL/RG/Misc. of
Hon'ble Punjab and Haryana High Court and orders of learned
District & Sessions Judge, Gurdaspur, bearing endorsement No.8229-
8237/P2C dated 31/05/2020 and No.8417-20/J.7 dated 04/06/2020.

2. Present petition has been moved by the petitioners with the
averments that complainant Sulakhan Singh went to Sharjah on
14/03/2019 but he was deported to India due to his earlier criminal record.

The petitioners incurred his all expenses i.e. air tickets of both sides, train tickets etc. The complainant had paid Rs.58,000/- to them and they spent more than Rs.70,000/-. Now after an year, complainant has filed a false complaint claiming money from them. The police is raiding upon their house for arresting them. Hence, the petitioners moved present application.

3. I have heard learned counsel for petitioner as well as of learned Additional Public Prosecutor for State and perused the record.

4. Today, ASI Banarsi Dass No.1128/GSP of Police Station E. O. Wing-II, SSP Office, Gurdaspur, appeared and suffered a statement that neither any complaint is pending nor any FIR has been registered against the petitioners at Police Station, E. O. Wing, Gurdaspur, till date. Above statement shows that this bail application is not maintainable because no FIR has been registered against the petitioners so far, as such, the present bail petition is hereby dismissed being infructuous. Record of present bail application be consigned to the record room.
