Today respondent-complainant Sakattar Singh has received a sum of Rs.10,000/- from appellant Surinder Singh and now no amount is due towards appellant Surinder Singh. Total amount of Rs.1,25,000/- has been received by respondent-complainant. His separate statement in this regard has been recorded.

At the same time, an application for compounding the offence has been moved by appellant-convict Surinder Singh, on which, respondent-complainant has made an endorsement of no objection if the offence is compounded and the appellant is acquitted. The parties have settled their dispute amicably and have buried their grudges.

The offence under Section 138 N.I. Act is compoundable in nature.

Let, matter be put up before Lok Adalat to be held on 14.09.2024 for further proceedings.
