ORDER:

Bail application put up with the remand papers pending in this court in the FIR in question for today. Police record has also been produced by ASI Gurdeep Singh, P.S. Makhu, which has been seen and returned. Arguments on bail application heard.

2. The FIR of this case was registered on the basis of a secret information. A naka was installed by SI Gurbachan Singh alongwith police party in the area of triangular crossing Jalanadhar-Makhu-Moga

road. The applicants were apprehended, who came in a Breeza car, which was being driven by non-applicant Harmesh Singh and the other non-applicant Davinder Singh was a pillion rider. The applicant was sitting on the side of the driver seat. On search of the car, drug money of Rs. 4,50,000/- and fake currency notes of Rs. 12,700/- were recovered. From the window of conductor side, 10 gram of Heroin wrapped in a polythene envelope and 200 tablets mark Tramadol Hydrochloride 100 Mg., Clovidol 100 SR were recovered. The applicant alongwith his co-accused were arrested. Now he is in judicial custody. Report of the FSL has not yet been received. It is on receipt of the FSL, it would be clear as to whether the recovery is commercial or less than commercial. No useful purpose is going to be served by keeping the applicant in jail. Rather it would be a burden on the Government Exchequer. Presentation of challan and its conclusion shall take time. So in view of the case law titled as **“Inderjeet Singh alias Laadi Versus State of Punjab” 2014(3), RCR (Crl.), 953**, applicant is ordered to be released on **interim bail**, on his furnishing interim bail bonds in the sum of Rs. 50,000/- with one surety of the like amount. Record of the bail application be attached with the remand papers. The claim of the applicant for regular bail shall be considered on receipt of the report of FSL.
