Heard. In this case, petitioner/accused was granted interim bail by this court on 5.2.2021. Learned APP for the State has produced on record copy of report of FSL, according to which the contents of intoxicating tablets claimed to have been recovered from possession of petitioner/accused were found to be Tramadol each tablets having average weight of 357 mg. In the present case, 300 loose intoxicating tablets claimed to have been recovered from possession of petitioner/accused and the total weight of 300 intoxicating tablets having salt Tramadol works out to be 107.1 grams, which falls under the non-commercial category. So, in the light of above situation, interim order dated 5.2.2021 is made absolute on the same terms and conditions.

The application is allowed accordingly. Papers of this bail application be tagged with the remand papers.
