ORDER:

1. Vide this order I will dispose of the bail application filed under Section 483 BNSS by applicant/accused Charanjit Singh @ Mottu, in the afore mentioned case.
2. Notice of the bail application was issued to the State and record was also summoned, which has been produced by the concerned police and has been perused.
3. Learned counsel for the applicant/accused argued that he has been falsely implicated in this case and he was not involved in the alleged commission of offence. The instant FIR was lodged on the basis of alleged secret information. The applicant was not even present at the place, disclosed in the FIR. Nothing has been recovered from the applicant and the alleged recovery has been planted by the police. The applicant is no more required by the police for the purpose of investigation. The applicant is in custody in this case since long, as such, he may be granted regular bail.

4. On the other hand, the learned Additional PP for the State has opposed the bail application on the ground that bail-applicant has committed heinous offence, so he does not deserve to be released on bail.

5. I have heard learned counsel for the applicant, learned Addl.PP for the State and have gone through the material on record.

6. The prosecution version, in brief, is that this case was registered on the basis of secret information received by the police party headed by ASI Amritpal Singh on 04.03.2026, to the effect that Charanjit Singh @ Motu son of Gurcharan Singh resident of Udham Singh Nagar, Bathinda, was habitual of committing theft of motor cycle. On that day also, he was riding on stolen motor cycle No. PB-03AW-7416 make Hero in grain market, Bathinda. On barricading, he could be apprehended. Thereafter, the police party swung into action and apprehended applicant Charanjit Singh @ Motu along with motor cycle No. PB-03AW-7416 and on interrogation, he disclosed that he had committed theft of said motor cycle 7-8 months ago from grain market, Bathinda.

7. The present case was registered on the basis of alleged secret information. The recovery of motor cycle in question has already been effected. The applicant is in custody since 04.03.2026. Presentation of challan and conclusion of trial would take considerable time. The culpability of the alleged offence is yet to be ascertained during the trial of the case. No useful purpose is going to be served by keeping the applicant in further custody as the same would amount to putting an additional burden on the State exchequer.

8. Thus, the instant bail application is allowed and the applicant/accused is ordered to be released on regular bail subject to furnishing of bail bonds and surety bonds in the sum of Rs.50,000/- to the satisfaction of concerned Area/Duty Magistrate, subject to the following conditions:

- a) That accused/applicant will not tamper with the prosecution evidence and will not offer any threat, promise or inducement, directly or indirectly to any of the person acquainted with the facts of the case, dissuading him from disclosing the same to the court/investigating agency; and
- b) That accused/applicant will not leave the limits of India without prior permission of the court.
- c) That accused/applicant will appear on each and every date of hearing. Subject to the order of exemption, trial court is at liberty to cancel the bail order.

9. Copy of the order be sent to the concerned court for necessary compliance.

10. Ahlmad is also directed to send copy of this order through e-mail to the Superintendent, Central Jail, Bathinda, forthwith, for necessary information as well as conveying the same to the bail applicant.

11. Bail application file be consigned to the Judicial Record Room, Bathinda.
