

BA 1599 of 2020 Raja Ram @ Rinku Vs. State of Punjab

ORDER :-

This order shall dispose of an application filed by the applicant Raja Ram @ Rinku for grant of regular bail in case F.I.R. No.145 dated 18.08.2020 under Section 18 of Narcotics Drugs and Psychotropic Substance Act, 1985, Police Station Dhakoli.

It has been averred in the application that the applicant/accused is innocent and has been falsely implicated in the present case. The applicant has not committed any offence. The applicant is patient and has already been operated for tongue cancer and is unable to eat the food and drink properly. He has no concern with the allegations made in the FIR. The presentation of challan and trial will take sufficient time. As such no useful purpose will be served by keeping the accused behind the bars.

The case of the prosecution is that the applicant Raja Ram was found moving in the area of Police Station Dhakoli and after seen the police party, he threw one polythene bag on the side of the road. Police apprehended him and from his search 100 gms of Heroin (falling in non-commercial quantity) was recovered.

The applicant is in custody from 18.08.2020. Contraband falling under non-commercial quantity has been recovered from him. As per the applicant, he has been suffering from ailment of tongue cancer and is not keeping good health. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the applicant/accused in custody, especially when no previous case is found to be registered against him. In view of facts and circumstances, the applicant is admitted to bail on his furnishing bail bonds /surety bonds in the sum of

₹1,00,000/- with one surety in the like amount. The applicant shall furnish personal bonds in the sum of ₹1,00,000/- only before the Jail Superintendent and is also directed to furnish surety bonds, when the situation become normal in respect of Covid-19 before the concerned Court/Illaq Magistrate. Jail Superintendent is further directed to return the said personal bonds to the office of Ld. District & Sessions Judge, S.A.S. Nagar, Mohali within ten days. Copy of this order be sent to the Jail Superintendent for its compliance. File be consigned to the Record Room.
