ORDER

This order of mine shall dispose off application filed by
applicant/accused for grant of regular bail.

2. It is submitted by learned counsel for the applicant/accused that he
is innocent and has been falsely implicated in this case. It has been further
submitted that nothing has been recovered from the applicant-accused.
Applicant-accused is in custody since the date of his arrest. It is prayed that
applicant/accused may be granted the concession of regular bail.

3. Ld. Addl.PP for the State opposed the bail application on the
ground that the offence committed by the accused is serious in nature.

4. Heard. Record perused.

5. As per the prosecution case, the FIR in the instant case has been registered against the applicant-accused on the allegations that he was found in possession of 20 KG of Poppy husk (including weight of plastic sack). The applicant is in custody since 04.08.2025 and not required for any investigation purposes. The presentation of challan and conclusion of trial will take sufficient time. No useful purpose shall be served by further detention of the accused behind the bars. Therefore, the application in hand stands allowed and the applicant/accused is admitted to regular bail on furnishing his bail bonds in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the concerned Illaqa/Duty Magistrate, subject to conditions as enumerated under the provisions of Section 483 of BNSS.

6. In case the applicant does not furnish bail bonds and surety bonds in compliance of this order within a period of one month from the date of order, Ahlmad is directed to report with regard to the same so that this Court may consider as to whether the conditions of bail require modification or relaxation. Ahlmad is also directed to send the soft copy of this order by email to the bail applicant through the Jail Superintendent today itself. A copy of this order be sent to the concerned quarter. Ahlmad is directed to attach the present papers with the remand papers.
