

KULDIP SINGH VS. STATE OF PUNJAB.

ORDER

Heard. Vide order dated 25.02.2026, applicant/accused Kuldeep Singh has been granted interim bail and was directed to join the investigation of the case to the satisfaction of the investigating officer. Today, vide his separate statement recorded before the court it is stated by ASI-Santokh Singh, Naib Court attached with this court has stated that in accordance with the telephonic information received from ASI-Shankar (IO), applicant/accused Kuldeep Singh has joined the investigation on dated 02.03.2026 and his custodial interrogation is not required in the case in hand. In the said backdrop, keeping in view these facts and circumstances, the order dated 25.02.2026 is hereby made absolute and application filed by the applicant/accused under Section 482 BNSS is allowed, subject to the following conditions:-

- 1.That applicant shall make himself available for interrogation by a police officer as and when required.
2. That applicant shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the courts or to any police officer.
- 3.That applicant shall not leave India without the prior permission of the Court.
4. That the applicant shall regularly attend the hearings before the trial court.

In case the applicant/accused misuses the concession of bail by absenting from the proceedings, the trial court shall be at liberty to cancel this bail order. File be consigned to record room.
