The record is placed before the Court upon an application submitted by the Investigating Officer and duly forwarded by the Learned PP-in-Charge, seeking issuance of a Production Warrant against one **Shyam Lal Harijan, son of Panchanand Harijan, resident of Kairibirpur, P.O. & P.S. Bishanpur, District Kishanganj, Bihar**, who is presently in custody in connection with Kishanganj P.S. Case No. 634 of 2026 dated 15.06.2026, under Section 112 of the BNS read with Sections 8(c)/18(c)/21(c)/29/31 of the NDPS Act, and is presently lodged at **Kishanganj Correctional Home, Kishanganj, Bihar**.
2. Learned PP-in-Charge submits that the said Shyam Lal Harijan, being the registered owner of the Scorpio vehicle employed for the illicit transportation of 408 grams of brown sugar, has surfaced as a person connected with the trafficking operation, his nexus with the present case having emerged in the course of investigation.
3. It is further submitted that, as the said Shyam Lal Harijan is presently confined at Kishanganj Correctional Home in connection with the aforesaid case, a Production Warrant is necessary to secure his physical production before this Court and to facilitate his formal arrest, if so warranted, in connection with the present case.
4. Hence, the prayer.
5. Heard the Learned PP-in-Charge. Perused the application, the materials available on record and the Case Diary produced by the Investigating Officer today.
6. The menace of narcotic substances is not merely an offence against an individual or an isolated breach of law; it is a corrosive evil that strikes at the very fabric of society, leaving its most grievous scars upon the youth, who constitute the future strength of the nation.
7. The Hon'ble Supreme Court, in State of Punjab v. Balraj Singh @ Billa¹, has characterised illicit trafficking and supply of narcotic substances as nothing short of a war waged against the nation.
8. Viewed in the light of the materials presently placed before the Court, and having regard to the nature and gravity of the allegations, this Court finds sufficient justification to allow the prayer made by the Investigating Officer.
9. Accordingly, a Production Warrant be issued against **Shyam Lal Harijan, son of Panchanand Harijan, resident of Kairibirpur, P.O. & P.S. Bishanpur, District Kishanganj, Bihar**, in terms of Section 302 of the BNSS, corresponding to Section 267 of the Cr.P.C., directing the **Superintendent, Kishanganj Correctional Home, Kishanganj, Bihar**, to secure and produce the said Shyam Lal Harijan **physically** before this Court on **25.08.2026**, positively and without fail.
10. The requisite Production Warrant, together with a copy of this order, be transmitted forthwith to the Superintendent, Kishanganj Correctional Home, Kishanganj, Bihar, for due and prompt compliance.
11. Fix **25.08.2026** for production of Shyam Lal Harijan and the other accused persons presently in custody.
