State Versus Nabi Saikh

Order no. 04
19.05.2026

- 1) Today is fixed for return of the police custody accused, namely Nabi Saikh, upon completion of the period of police remand earlier granted by this Court.
- 2) However, the accused has not been produced before the Court today.
- 3) Learned PP-in-Charge, being ably assisted by the Investigating Officer, submits that on 16.05.2026 the accused suddenly fell seriously ill and was consequently admitted to Raiganj Government Medical College and Hospital for immediate medical intervention and treatment.
- 4) The Investigating Officer has, today, submitted a detailed report annexing photocopies of relevant medical documents and hospital papers evidencing the hospitalization and ongoing treatment of the accused.
- 5) It further transpires from the record that the Investigating Officer had promptly intimated this Court on 16.05.2026 regarding the sudden hospitalization of the accused, thereby demonstrating due compliance with procedural propriety.
- 6) On a pointed query from this Court, the Investigating Officer submits that, as per information received from the attending medical practitioner, the accused is likely to be discharged from the hospital tomorrow, subject to his medical condition remaining stable.
- 7) In view of the foregoing circumstances, the Investigating Officer is hereby directed to ensure the immediate production of the accused before this Court forthwith upon his discharge from the hospital, along with the discharge summary, treatment papers, prescriptions, and all connected medical documents, so as to enable this Court to judiciously determine the further course of action concerning the health condition and custodial status of the accused.
- 8) Let a copy of this order be forthwith forwarded to the Deputy Superintendent of Police (Headquarters), Raiganj Police District, who had recommended the prayer for police custody, and also to the Inspector-in-Charge, Raiganj Police Station, with a firm direction to maintain strict supervision over the proper medical treatment of the accused and to ensure, without any avoidable delay, his production before this Court immediately after discharge from the hospital. Any lapse in compliance shall be viewed with due seriousness.
- 9) Fix **21.05.2026** for production of the accused and submission of a further report by the Investigating Officer.
