COMMITMENT ORDER:

1. The above named accused has been sent up by the Officer-in-charge of Police Station Sadar, Jalandhar in FIR No.80 dated 10.05.2018 to face trial under Section 376 IPC & 4,8 of Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act.
2. Succinct version of prosecution version envisages that FIR of case in hand was registered on the basis of statement recorded by prosecutrix to the Police that she studied upto 8th class. She knew Rohit Kumar for the last 5-6 months. On 09.05.2018 at about 7:30 P.M, she was asked to reach at Khambra Adda by above-named accused through mobile phone. When she reached at said place, above-named accused along with two other boys came there on a scooter. They all took her in a plot and committed rape with her. On the said statement of complainant, FIR was registered. On 13.05.2018, accused was arrested. Statement u/s 164 Cr.P.C of

prosecutrix was got recorded. After completion of investigation, challan against accused was presented before the Court for trial.

3. Copies of challan and requisite documents as relied upon by the prosecution were supplied to the accused free of cost in compliance with provisions of section 207 of Cr.P.C.
4. Heard. From the perusal of file and material available on record, offence punishable under Sections 376 IPC & 4, 8 of Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act appear to have been made out against the accused. Offence punishable under Section 4,8 of Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act is triable by the learned Special Court, whereas, offence punishable U/s 376 IPC is triable by Court of Sessions. As such, this case is committed to the Court of Sessions for 05.09.2018. Accused be produced before the said Ld. Court on said date. Ahlmad is directed to send the file, complete in all respects, to the Court of learned Sessions Judge, Jalandhar, well before the date fixed. This order of commitment be also notified to the learned Public Prosecutor.
