

Mubarak Masih @ Deepu Vs. State of Punjab

1. Accused/applicant Mubarak Masih @ Deepu son of Chanchal Masih has sought regular bail in case arising out of FIR No. 92 dated 22.08.2023 under Sections 379-B,411,201,34 IPC, Police Station Sadar Batala.

2. Heard. The accused/applicant was on bail in this case but he absented from the proceedings on 27.03.2024 i.e. the first date fixed in the case for recording the evidence of the prosecution. However, later on he was produced before the Court by his surety on 26.04.2024. No doubt, his brother Major Gill is also involved in this case and another case but he is involved in a case under the NDPS Act also. It is submitted that since both the brothers are in custody, their family is facing acute difficulties. Keeping in view the entire facts and circumstances, the instant application is allowed and the accused/applicant is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing of bail bonds in the sum of Rs.25,000/- with one surety in the like amount but he shall remain bound by the following conditions:-

1. that the accused-applicant shall furnish his latest address and mobile number to the Court at the time of furnishing the bail bonds and in case there is any change in his residential address or mobile number subsequently, it would be his responsibility to inform the Court in this regard.

2. that the accused/applicant shall not leave the country without the prior permission of the Ilaqa Magistrate till presentation of challan and thereafter without the permission of the trial Court;
3. that the accused-applicant shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer;
4. that the accused-applicant shall not involve himself in the commission of any offence of similar nature; and
5. that the accused-applicant shall regularly attend the hearings before the trial Court.
